# The Application Guidance: Through the Shorelight Admissions Portal

#### STEP 1 Submit via Shorelight Admissions Portal

- Go to the Shorelight admission portal: https://admissions.shorelight.com/login
- · Click"Apply Now" in the top right corner to start your application.
- Begin filling in your basic information. (For the email address, please be sure to provide an accurate address that belongs to the student. This email must be consistent with the one used for the official university application.)
- Select Stony Brook University, then choose your desired program and the correct start term.

Please complete the Shorelight admission portal application step by step, providing accurate application information and materials. Shorelight will conduct an initial review upon receipt of the application.

#### **Materials Required for Shorelight Portal**

- Copy of Official Transcripts: Secondary school transcripts (grades 9-present); University transcripts (if applicable).
- If graduated, English copy of official high school diploma
- If requesting an English waiver, complete and upload the English Waiver Form

- · Essay (Required for Freshmen; Optional for Transfers).
- Recommendation Letter(s) (Required: 1 for Freshmen; Optional for Transfers).

#### **Submission Methods:**

- 1) PDF Format: Upload to 'Miscellaneous' section in Shorelight Checklist; include recommender's name, signature, and contact details.
- 2) Email: Upload the completed 'Recommendation Letter Information Collection Form' (signed by student) to 'Miscellaneous'. After receiving "application submitted to Stony Brook University" confirmation, the recommender emails the letter directly to upprocessing@stonybrook.edu

#### Notes:

- A-Level/IB: Official or predicted scores required. If not taking final exams, a signed student statement is needed.
- Transfer application generally does not require third-party credential evaluation, but may be requested to do the WES evaluation for international transcripts case by case.
- Music majors must complete a separate application to the College of Music:

#### STEP 2 Await University Decision

- 1.After Shorelight submission, when the portal status changes to 'Final Review' and you see the message "Your application has been submitted to Stony Brook University" (or receive a confirmation email), the application has been successfully submitted.
- 2.Students will receive an email notification from Stony Brook University in their student inbox and must activate the Stony Brook Application Portal as instructed. They can then check their application status and results through the university portal.

\*If already submitted materials are not shown as received in the SBU Portal, or if no email notification from Stony Brook University is received within two weeks, please contact the university's international admissions office directly at enrollintl@stonybrook.edu.

The application fee is \$50 (waived for applications submitted between October 20 and November 3, subject to the timestamp when Shorelight flips the application to Stony Brook University).

Tuition deposit: \$150

On-campus housing deposit: \$200

New student fee (includes Orientation, etc.): \$325

# Important Notes

- 1.Applicants can select only one major via the Shorelight Admissions Portal.
- 2. For an undeclared major, select 'General/Undeclared'.
- 3. The application fee typically appears on the Stony Brook University Portal checklist. If not, it may be billed upon enrollment and does not hinder application review.
- 4.Students conditionally admitted who later meet Direct Admission language requirements should contact the Stony Brook Admissions Office to request an update, subject to availability.
- 5.Transfer Credit: Direct Admission students are evaluated after depositing. Conditional Admission students are evaluated upon completion of IEC, prior to matriculation into Direct Admission programs.
- 6. Final official transcripts must be sent directly from the school/counselor to the Stony Brook University Admissions Office.

7.The Pathway and English programs are university-administered. The Students can progress into the bachelor degree program upon the success completion of IEC or UP program.

IEC Program usually takes 2 semesters to complete IEC 103 and 104


UP 1 Program usually takes 2 semesters to complete with 9 credits and IEC 103 & 104
