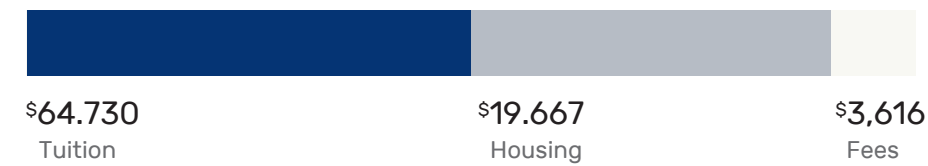

English Proficiency	TOEFL: 100 IELTS: 7.0 (The university does not accept Duolingo scores or TOEFL MyBest scores from multiple test sittings. TOEFL Home Edition Accepted Official score delivery code: C559)
	English Proficiency Test Waiver Policy You may be eligible for a waiver if you meet at least one of the following criteria: 1. Citizenship Waiver: You hold a passport from a country where English is an official language. 2. Degree Waiver: You have obtained or will obtain a bachelor's or master's degree from a country where English is an official language. 3. Instruction Waiver: Your degree was earned in a country where English is not an official language, but the language of instruction for the entire program was English. (Official proof of the language of instruction is required.) Through the Shorelight Admissions Portal

STEP 1 | Submit Official Application to the University

- 1.Submit your official application on the Johns Hopkins Univer-sity Whiting School of Engineering website: <https://applygrad.jhu.edu/apply/?s-r=a2ae7785-6082-475c-8418-33159161cba3>
 - 2.Once you've submitted your application to Johns Hopkins University, you could contact them directly for all questions regarding your application status, such as admission decisions or requests for additional documents, contact email: WSEGrad-Admissions@jhu.edu
- Please also remember to check the Johns Hopkins University application system for your final admission result.

STEP 2 | Submit via Shorelight Admissions Portal for Record

- 1.Go to the Shorelight admission portal: <https://admissions.shorelight.com/login>
 - 2.Click"Apply Now" in the top right corner to start your application.
 - 3.Begin filling in your basic information. (For the email address, please be sure to provide an accurate address that belongs to the student. This email must be consistent with the one used for the official university application.)
 - 4.Select Johns Hopkins University, then choose your desired program and the correct start term."
- Please complete the Shorelight admission portal application step by step, providing accurate application information and materials. Shorelight will conduct an initial review upon receipt of the application.

Materials Required for Shorelight Portal

- 1.University Transcripts (A minimum GPA of 3.0 is required. If your GPA is below 3.0, you may submit a WES evaluation report to meet the 3.0 GPA requirement.)
- 2.Language Test Scores (if required)
- 3.Proof of JHU Submission

- 2. **Credential Evaluation:** JHU strongly recommend professional credential evaluation services for all foreign academic work, JHU recommends World Education Services (WES) or SpanTran.
- 3. **Multiple Applications:** The JHU Whiting School of Engineering's official website can accept multiple applications from the same applicant. However, the Shorelight Portal can only accommodate one applica-tion per student. If you are later admitted to a different program through the official website, you can contact the Shorelight Advisor to try to manually change the record.
- 4. **Applying to Multiple Schools:** If a student plans to apply to multiple JHU schools, it is crucial to first complete the application for the Whiting School of Engineering to ensure proper lead tracking.
