STEP 1 Submit via Shorelight Admissions Portal for Record

- Go to the Shorelight admission portal: https://admissions.shorelight.com/login
- · Click"Apply Now" in the top right corner to start your application.
- Begin filling in your basic information. (For the email address, please be sure to provide an accurate address that belongs to the student. This email must be consistent with the one used for the official university application.)
- Select University of Virigina, then choose your desired program and the correct start term."

Please complete the Shorelight admission portal application step by step, providing accurate application information and materials. Shorelight will conduct an initial review upon receipt of the application.

Materials Required for Shorelight Portal

- Complete Official Transcripts
- Official Language Score Report or English waiver form
- If graduated, English copy of official university diploma
- Resume/CV
- Statement of Purpose

STEP 2 Complete University Portal Application

1.Once the Shorelight Portal status changes to "Final Review" and displays the message "Your application has been submitted to Virginia University", the student's email box will receive a confirmation notification and further instructions from the University of Virginia.

2. Follow the university's instructions to complete the application, including submitting 3 letters of recommendation and any other required steps.

For subsequent status checks or questions, please contact the university directly.
