- · Graziadio School of Business: The business school combines practical learning with innovation, offering curricula that reflect the latest industry trends. Its global perspective is highly recognized, with its MBA ranking among the top 25 globally by CEO Magazine. The school is ranked #95 (tie) among Best Business Schools by U.S. News & World Report (2024).
- School of Public Policy (SPP): The SPP boasts a strong alumni network in government, the World Bank, NGOs, and think tanks, particularly in Southern California and Washington, D.C.. It is consistently a top choice for the Master of Public Policy (MPP) according to NCES, and is ranked in the top 10 for Western public policy programs. The program maintains an excellent 5:1

Admission Requirements (Detailed requirements are subject to the official university website)

Academic Requirements

- School of Business & Law School: A minimum undergraduate GPA of 2.6 is required.
- · School of Public Policy: A minimum undergraduate GPA of 2.0 is required.
- WES/NACES Evaluation: For the Law School and Public Policy School, a NACES evaluation is required for all non-U.S. transcripts. For the Business School, NACES evaluation is required for non-U.S. degrees.

Language Test Waiver Policies:

- · School of Business: Applicants with a bachelor's and/or graduate degree from a U.S. accredited college or university, or a degree from a foreign institution where the language of instruction was English, may be eligible for a waiver.
- · Law School: Applicants seeking a waiver must submit their application materials to strausadmissions@pepperdine.edu for review, and if approved, an online interview will be scheduled.
- · School of Public Policy: Applicants who have completed four or more years at a regionally accredited English-taught institution may be exempt.

Law School Note: Applicants whose TOEFL/IELTS scores are just below the minimum required can

Other Application Requirements

The GRE/GMAT is optional for all three schools. In addition to transcripts and test scores, applicants must submit the following materials:

- **School of Business:** Requires a Personal Statement (recommended to highlight strengths related to the program) and a CV, with one optional Recommendation Letter.
- Caruso School of Law: Requires a Personal Statement, a CV/Resume, and one Recommendation Letter.
- School of Public Policy: Requires a Personal Statement (2-3 page essay), a CV, two Recommendation Letters (preferably one academic and one professional), and a separate Moral Dilemma Essay (1-2 pages).

Estimate Tuition and Cost

School of Business

STEP 1 Submit via Shorelight Admissions Portal only

- 1.Go to the Shorelight admission portal: https://admissions.shorelight.com/login
- 2.Click"Apply Now" in the top right corner to start your application.
- 3.Begin filling in your basic information. (For the email address, please be sure to provide an accurate address that belongs to the student. This email must be consistent with the one used for the official university application.)
- 4. Select Pepperdine University, then choose your desired program and the correct start term.

1.University Transcripts (GPA 2.6 or above)

2.English proficiency scores: TOEFL iBT 90 / IELTS 6.0

- 1. Business School: After submitting the SL Portal application, you must also complete the separate application on the official Business School website.
- 2. Business School Application Fee Waiver:

On the Business CAS application, when asked:

"Are you applying with the support of a Shorelight educational advisor or via a Shorelight admissions platform?"

You must answer "Yes" and provide your Shorelight ID to qualify for the application fee waiver and be recognized as a partnership student.

School of Law

STEP 1 Submit via Shorelight Admissions Portal only

1. Shorelight Portal Application

Log in to the Shorelight Admission Portal: [https://admissions.shorelight.com/login] Select Pepperdine University, then choose your program and intake term. Submit all required documents through the SL portal. After the application is complete, Shorelight Admissions will forward your materials to Pepperdine Law School for review.

2. SL Portal Document Checklist

1)Transcript: Minimum GPA 2.6+. NACES evaluation is required for all non-U.S. transcripts. The school will create an LSAC account for the student.

2)(If the student already has an LSAC account with a CAS Report from previous applications, NACES evaluation is not required.)

3)Language Scores: TOEFL iBT 95 or IELTS 6.5.

- 4)Alternatively, if the student believes they qualify for an English proficiency waiver, they may request an online interview.
- 5)(Submit a written statement outlining how the requirement is met, along with supporting documents, to strausadmissions@pepperdine.edu.)
- 6)GRE/GMAT: Optional
- 7)Personal Statement
- 8)CV/Resume
- 9)One Recommendation Letter
- a)Option 1: Upload a signed PDF letter on official letterhead (with recommender's contact information at the bottom) to the "Miscellaneous" section of the SL Portal Checklist.
- b)Option 2: Have the recommender email the letter directly to StrausAdmissions@pepperdine.edu.
- (Upload a completed *Recommendation Letter Information Collection Form* with recommender details and student signature to the "Miscellaneous" section.)

School of Public Policy

STEP 1 Submit via Shorelight Admissions Portal only

- 1.Shorelight Portal Application
- Log in to the Shorelight Admission Portal: https://admissions.shorelight.com/login. Select Pepperdine University, then choose your program and intake term.
- 2.Submit all required documents through the SL Portal for comprehensive review by the university. Required Documents for SL Portal Submission:
- a)Transcripts: Minimum GPA 2.0. Non-U.S. transcripts require NACES certification.
- b)English Proficiency Scores: TOEFL iBT 95 / IELTS 7.0 / Duolingo 130.
- c)GRE/GMAT: Optional.
- d)Pepperdine, and any additional information for the admissions committee.
- e)CV
- f)The personal statement (2-3 page essay) indicating interest in studying public policy, reason for choosing to apply to the Pepperdine School of Public Policy, and any other information that should be considered by the admission committee.
- g)The moral dilemma essay** (1-2 pages) should explain an ethical or moral dilemma the student faced in recent years and describe their reaction and solution to the particular challenge.
- h)Two Recommendation Letters** (preferably one academic and one professional):
 - i.Option 1: Upload a PDF letter to the "Miscellaneous" section in the SL Portal Checklist. Must be

on official letterhead (e.g., university/company). Include recommender's contact details at the bottom and a handwritten signature.

ii.Option 2: Have the recommender email the letter directly to sppadmissions@pepperdine.edu. Upload a completed and signed *Recommendation Letter Information Collection Form* (with recommender's details) to the "Miscellaneous" section.

The recommender must email the letter from their official email account.
